



### Project Overview

The community centre was a joint venture for the Pittsworth State School and the Pittsworth Shire Council for use as Classrooms and Conference Centre. The facility is a new 706m<sup>2</sup> building located within the school grounds. The facility is run by council and is used by the state school, council, and local community groups. To maximise functionality of the centre, the architect incorporated the use of operable walls to provide flexible teaching and communal facilities.

The building is constructed using structural steel and timber framing clad with corrugated iron and render fibre cement sheeting. The entrance foyer features Tasmanian Oak ceilings with a vaulted clear storey to maximize natural lighting. The communal kitchen is finished with commercial grade stainless steel bench tops and sinks to maximize workability and durability of the facility.

A new concrete car park for 27 cars was constructed to providing suitable off street amenity.
