Activities	Impact
Construction Works Zone	Active Managed footpath & vehicle movements to ensure public safety around site activities.
Hoardings	Active Pedestrian access along Riley Street remains in-tact Pedestrian access within Lower Campbell Street is limited to footpath opposite the work site Traffic control managed footpath & vehicle movements to ensure public safety around site activities
Scaffold	Commenced Scaffold encapsulation of building perimeter has commenced and will be ongoing as the structure progresses
Structure	Ongoing construction of the primary structure. Managed footpath & vehicle movements to ensure public safety around site activities as required.
COVID-19 Management	 Active – Sydney wide lockdown currently in affect, however construction sites remain exempt from NSW government mandates requiring closure of workplaces. Due to the nature of the works, mask mandates are also exempt form NSW construction sites. We do however encourage all on our site to wear these where possible Sanitisation stations are provided throughout the site Lunch breaks are staggered where required to maintain social distancing in the site amenities Attendance registers are maintained in accordance with government regulations.
