

Community Notification – Tree Removal to North Quay**205 North Quay, Brisbane City – Out of Hours Works 6pm 9th to 6am 10th September 2021**

Date 8/09/2021

Proposed Works

Removal of one (1) leopardwood tree along 205 North is scheduled as part of the development works at 205 North Quay.

- Works have been approved by Brisbane City Council under a Natural Assets Local Law Approval to Interfere with Protected Vegetation Permit.
- Works will be undertaken by a Council Approved arborist.
- Upon completion of the site, new trees will be planted in accordance with the NALL Permit.

The removal of an existing council tree to 205 North Quay footpath will occur between the 9th to the 10th of September 2021. Out of hours works are expected between the hours of 6:00pm and 6:00am.

- On the 9th of September at 7pm traffic control will temporarily close the shoulder lane along 205 North Quay in accordance with approved Traffic Guidance Scheme.
- One (1) tree will be removed by a Council Approved arborist.
- The temporary lane closure will be removed by 5am.
- Work area will be cleaned and opened to public by 6am.
- A variety of equipment will be used to complete the works including chainsaws. All noise will be kept to a minimum as permitted by the works.
